

2024 - 2025 Competition Team Information Packet

Audition Information:

Audition Dates & Times:

Students are required to attend all 3 days of Auditions. Students must be entering Kindergarten as of August 2024. Students should choose a group to attend with based off of their upcoming school year grade for August 2024. The group students audition with will not effect the team placement. For example, a 3rd grader and 4th grader could end up on the same team if their technique is similar.

Day I - Tuesday, May 21st (Learn Audition Material)

Grades Kind. - **3rd:** Check in at 5:15 p.m. Class from 5:30 - 6:45 p.m. **Grades 4th** - **7th:** Check in at 6:30 p.m. Class from 6:45 - 9:00 p.m. **Grades 8th** - **12th:** Check in at 3:00 p.m. Class from 3:15 - 5:30 p.m.

Day 2 - Wednesday, May 22nd - (Audition)

Grades Kind. - 3rd: Check in at 5:15 p.m. Class from 5:30 - 6:45 p.m. **Grades 4th - 7th:** Check in at 6:30 p.m. Class from 6:45 - 9:00 p.m. **Grades 8th - 12th:** Check in at 3:00 p.m. Class from 3:15 - 5:30 p.m.

Day 3 - Thursday, May 23rd- (Call Backs)

* Parents will be emailed in the morning (on Thursday, May 23rd) at 10:00 a.m. with their individual call back time for this day. All Students will be called back and will be asked to come for a final audition between 3:00 - 9:00 p.m.

A \$30.00 audition fee is due as well as the \$35.00 annual registration fee at check out.

Audition Attire & Items to Bring:

- * Please come looking your best for auditions. Hair must be in a slicked back bun or low pony tail.
- * Wear any color of fitted tank top with fitted dance shorts or leggings.
- * Bring turning shoes, ballet shoes & any type of tennis shoes. If you do not own these items, they are available to purchase at the studio.
- * Bring the last 3 pages of this packet.

About UDC Auditions:

The purpose for holding auditions is to ensure that dancers are placed with the correct team for the upcoming year based off of their current level of dance technique. Auditions will run like a regular dance class. Dancers will warm up and show flexibility. They will also show jazz, ballet and hip hop technique. Dancers do not need to prepare any type of routine prior to the audition.

Dancers will be placed on teams based off of technique level. Students are not placed on teams based off of parent opinion or wish. The placement auditions are closed to parents. We have teams for beginning, intermediate and advanced technical dancers. All are welcome to audition. If your student does not make the team, we will help you make a personalized plan for your student for the upcoming year.

Team Lists Announcement:

Teams will be emailed out on Friday, May 31st at 11:00 a.m. Other important information will be available such as the required class schedules for the Competition Team Summer Course & the school year. We are not able to create the class schedules until auditions are over and teams are created.

Competition Team Requirements & Expectations:

Class Attendance:

Consistent class attendance is extremely important for a dancer to progress, grow and improve. One student's absence effects the entire class of students, therefore all dancers are expected to come to class each week, and on time. Absences will be monitored. If a student is absent 2 times in any required class, parents will be contacted. If a student is absent 3 times in any required class, parents will be contacted and students will be considered on probation. If a student is absent a 4th time, the dancer may end up being removed from the team at the Directors discretion. We understand that emergencies and illness happen. If your student must miss class, we ask that you let us know ahead of time so that the absence will be marked as excused prior to missing class. We do not have make up classes for students and tuition will not be discounted for missed classes. Students should not miss class for reasons such as birthday parties, going shopping, extended family in town, or orthodontic appointments (please schedule these appointments at other times).

Priority & Commitment:

Dancers must make competition dance practice their priority. All other extra curricular activities will need to be secondary to our required team class times. Students should not participate in other sports or in school plays if it conflicts with our practice times.

It is expected that dancers who are placed on a Competition Team commit to both the 6 week summer course, and the entire 2024 - 2025 school year. When a student does not fulfill their obligation to complete the entire school year, it effects the entire team and they will be charged the \$200.00 Cancellation Fee.

Cancelation Fee: \$200.00

Dancers who audition and then do not fulfill their commitment from June 2024 - May 2025 will be charged a Cancelation Fee of \$200.00. This policy begins once the student auditions for a team. There are no exceptions. Parents and dancers should take this into consideration prior to auditioning. If a student quits at any time between May 2024 - May 2025 (including prior to the summer course starting) the same rule applies and the \$200.00 Cancelation Fee will be charged.

Summer Course Requirement:

We will hold 6 weeks of class from June 17th - July 26th for the new Competitions Teams! *Competition Dancers are required to attend the summer course to keep up and improve technique throughout the summer.* If a dancer has a family vacation or girls camp already planned during that time, please email Megan (UDC Director) to discuss the conflict. Dancers who are placed on a competition team will automatically be registered for the summer course after they are placed on a team. The Summer Course fee will be due June 1st.

Convention Requirement:

Dance conventions are 2-3 day events of dance classes taught by industry professionals from all over the U.S. Attending conventions teaches dancers to reach their full potential and is also an amazing team bonding opportunity. Our studio attends two conventions each year. The first convention is the Epic Convention on September 6th & 7th. It will be held in the Ogden area and will cost approx \$250.00. The second convention will be held in early spring of 2025 near Provo and will cost approx. \$250.00.

All of our advanced level dancers who make a "Pro" track team will be required to attend the Spring Convention, but will have the option of also attending the fall convention. All other competition team dancers are required to attend the Fall convention, and are welcome to attend the Spring convention if they wish. The convention fee for the Epic convention will be due July 1st. The second convention fee will be due November 1st. Details to come.

Competition Team Requirements & Expectations:

Competitions & Recital:

Each Competition Team will have 1-4 competition routines for the upcoming school year. Each team will also have one ballet routine for our Studio Winter Recital. All United Dance Center students will participate in our Winter and Spring Recitals. We do not charge a recital fee. Tickets will be approximately \$8.00 for all spectators to help cover building rental costs.

Competition Dancers are required to attend three local competitions and one competition in St George; totaling 4 competitions in the Spring of 2025. All competitions charge a fee of approximately \$40.00 per dancer, per routine. The competition fee will be due on August 1st, 2024 for the upcoming season.

Costumes, Make Up & Earrings Requirement:

Each routine dancers participate in will require a costume. We try very hard to find high quality, appropriate costumes at a good price. Competition costumes are \$90.00 per dancer, per routine. For teams who compete a hip hop routine, costumes are \$120.00 because tennis shoes will be included with the costume (unlike other costumes). The costume fee will be due September 1st for competition dancers. Dancers will be required to purchase the correct dance shoes and tights for their specific team for competition. Dancers will be required to purchase one pair of clip-on or regular earrings for performances as well as one team lipstick for the year. Dancers will be required to purchase turning shoes for class and have an additional pair for performances only.

Team Warm Ups/Spirit Attire:

Warm up jackets cost approximately \$85.00 and pants cost approximately \$35.00. Tank tops, t-shirts, and hoodies will also be available for purchase.

All Competition Dancers are required to purchase either a team jacket or team t-shirt if they do not already own one. Dancers will be asked to wear a United Dance Center T-shirt or Jacket at Competitions. Purchasing more than one item is optional. Dancers are welcome to wear these items to school. Information to come in September.

Class Attire:

Wearing the correct class attire is important! Dancers are expected to wear the correct attire to every class.

<u>Ballet Attire</u> - Wearing a ballet leotard to class is required. Leotards may have a short cap sleeve, or tank top type straps. Light Pink Tights and Light Pink Canvas shoes must be purchased at UDC's Studio Store. Short (mid thigh), thin ballet skirts are optional. Hair must be pulled back into a bun. Tights with holes (larger than the size of a quarter) are not accepted for class. Holes smaller than a quarter may be stopped from running with a small amount of clear nail polish.

<u>Jazz/Contemporary/Lyrical Attire</u> - Dancers must wear dance shorts or fitted leggings with a fitted tank top, or a fitted cap sleeved shirt. No baggy t-shirts are allowed. Dancers will be required to purchase turning shoes for the summer course at UDC's studio store. As noted above, dancers will be required to purchase the correct shoes and tights for competition/performances. More information will come for performance shoes/tights. Hair must be pulled back into a bun or a pony tail.

<u>Hip Hop Attire</u> - Dancers may wear the attire listed above for Jazz, with the option of adding on baggy, stretchy pants, and a baggy t-shirt. Sneakers are required for this class (any sneakers that the dancers wear to school, work great. No platform type tennis shoes allowed).

Weekly Classes:

Competition Students are required to take a variety of classes with their team (such as Ballet, Jazz, Hip Hop, Acrobatic Tumbling and some teams add on Lyrical/Contemporary). Intermediate and Advanced teams will take ballet 2+ times per week. Students must take all team classes. They cannot pick and choose which classes they take.

Acrobatic Tumbling has become a very important part of competitive dance. Competition Students will be required to take a tumbling class in addition to their team dance classes.

"Mini Teams" are for students who are approximately 5 - 7 years old.

Mini Dancers take approximately 4 hours of class per week (2 days weekly). They will have 2 competition routines (Jazz and Hip Hop). Weekly classes may include: Jazz Choreography, Hip Hop Choreography, Acrobatic Tumbling, and Jazz/Ballet Technique.

"Junior and Pre Teen Teams" are for students who are approximately 7 - 12 years old.

Junior and Pre Teen Dancers take approximately 4 - 7 hours of class per week (2 - 3 days weekly). They will have 2 - 3 competition routines (Jazz, Hip Hop, and possibly Lyrical). Weekly classes may include: Jazz Choreography, Hip Hop Choreography, Lyrical Choreography, Acrobatic Tumbling, Ballet and Jazz technique.

"Teen and Senior Teams" are for students who are approximately 12 - 18 years old.

Teen and Senior Dancers take approximately 7 - 10+ hours of class per week (3 - 4 days weekly). They will have 3 - 4 competition routines (Jazz, Hip Hop, Lyrical and possibly Contemporary). Weekly classes may include: Jazz Choreography, Hip Hop Choreography, Lyrical Choreography, Contemporary Choreography, Acrobatic Tumbling, Ballet, and Jazz Technique. Additional classes may be offered such as production number classes, pure pointe classes and ballroom classes.
